

RESOLUTION NO. 2-2024

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO APPROVE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AND AFSCME OHIO COUNCIL 8 AND LOCAL 1958 AND OHIO COUNCIL 8, SERVICE, MAINTENANCE, AND TECHNICAL EMPLOYEES CHAPTER AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ON THE CITY'S BEHALF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of New Philadelphia Administration desires to attract more hires by offering competitive wages for sanitation laborers; and

WHEREAS, Said rates are subject to the current contract existing between the City and AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter and would require a Memorandum of Agreement between the parties to effectuate a rate change under the existing contract; and

WHEREAS, The Parties have reached a tentative agreement in the form of a "Memorandum of Agreement", which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio does hereby approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of New Philadelphia and AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter, which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten, and authorizes the Mayor and the Service Director to sign the same on behalf of the City for the purposes of increasing the new hire rates for sanitation laborers.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


