

RESOLUTION NO. 27-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA TO EXECUTE AND FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY DISTRICT AND TO PROVIDE ALL INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO BECOME ELIGIBLE FOR POSSIBLE FUNDING ASSISTANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District administers financial assistance for conservation purposes through the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia desires financial assistance under the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of New Philadelphia:

SECTION 1. That the City of New Philadelphia approves filing an application for financial assistance and entering into a grant agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the City of New Philadelphia is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3. That the City of New Philadelphia does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
