

ORDINANCE NO. 12-2016

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE, ADOPT AND ENACT THE CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revisions; and

WHEREAS, the codification of such ordinances, together with the new matter to be adopted, the matters to be amended and those to be repealed are before the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2016 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. That the following sections and chapters are hereby enacted, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law:

Traffic Code

- 301.19 Motorcycle . (Amended)
- 303.081 Impounding Vehicles on Private Residential Property. (Amended)
- 303.082 Tow Away Zones. (Amended)
- 335.031 Driving With Probationary License; Curfew. (Amended)
- 335.09 Display of License Plates. (Amended)
- 335.10 Expired or Unlawful License Plates. (Amended)
- 341.01 Definitions. (Amended)
- 341.03 Prerequisites to Operation of a Commercial Vehicle. (Amended)
- 341.05 Criminal Offenses. (Amended)
- 341.06 Employment of Drivers of Commercial Vehicles. (Amended)
- 351.04 Parking Near Curb; Handicapped Parking. (Amended)
- 373.02 Riding Upon seats; Handlebars; Helmets and Glasses. (Amended)

General Offenses Code

- 529.07 Open Container Prohibited. (Amended)

SECTION 3. The complete text of the Traffic and General Offenses Code sections listed above are set forth in full in the 2016 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A. Any summary publication of this ordinance shall include a complete listing of these sections. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is necessary to bring the Traffic and General Offenses Codes into compliance with current State law as required by Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


