

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2025

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 1339-WIND ENERGY FACILITIES AND CHAPTER 1333-DOWNTOWN DESIGN STANDARDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a need repeal Chapters 1339 and 1333 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of New Philadelphia, as those issues are now addressed in the new zoning code enacted by the Council of the City of New Philadelphia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Existing Codified Ordinance Chapter 1339 – Wind Energy Facilities, is hereby repealed in total.

SECTION 2. Existing Codified Ordinance Chapter 1333-Downtown Design Standards is hereby repealed in total.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


