

ORDINANCE NO. 16-2018

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 4-2018 WHICH MODIFIED SECTION 509.03 "DISORDERLY CONDUCT; INTOXICATION," OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio desires to repeal Ordinance No. 4-2018 in favor of increasing the mandatory minimum fines under Codified Ordinance Section 509.03, which shall be addressed with separate legislation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4-2018 is hereby repealed in total.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.


