

ORDINANCE NO. 19-2019

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO CREATE THE NEW PHILADELPHIA SAFER GRANT FUND #224 FOR THE PURPOSES OF MANAGING ALL FUNDS RECEIVED FROM FEMA PURSUANT TO THE CITY'S AWARD UNDER THE SAFER GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio has found it necessary to establish the New Philadelphia SAFER Grant Fund #224 for the purposes of managing all funds received from FEMA pursuant to the city's award under the SAFER Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the New Philadelphia City Auditor will need to create a new account entitled the "New Philadelphia SAFER Grant Fund #224 " for said purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The New Philadelphia City Auditor shall create a new account entitled the "New Philadelphia SAFER Grant Fund #224 ".

SECTION 2. The New Philadelphia City Auditor shall deposit all monies received from FEMA pursuant to the city's award under the SAFER Grant Program.



SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.


