

ORDINANCE NO. 21-2019

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, State of Ohio, that to provide for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of New Philadelphia during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, the sums be and are hereby set aside and appropriated as listed in the attached appropriations under the heading 2020 Temporary Appropriations and that they be appropriated from the general fund: See attached.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasurer for payments from many of the foregoing appropriations upon receipt of proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve the same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of a 2/3 vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
