## RESOLUTION NO. 31-2016

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO ADOPT THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AND LOCAL 1958 AND OHIO COUNCIL 8 AFSCME, AFL CIO TO BE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of New Philadelphia Administration participated with AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter in interest based bargaining; and

WHEREAS, The Parties reached a tentative agreement in the interest based bargaining; and

WHEREAS, The AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter have adopted the tentative agreement; and

WHEREAS, The City of New Philadelphia by adopting the tentative agreement has reached a new contract for the time period from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2018 between the City of New Philadelphia and AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The agreement reached between the City of New Philadelphia and AFSCME Local 1958 and Ohio Council 8, Service, Service, Maintenance, and Technical Employees Chapter, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein, is hereby adopted by the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio as the contract between Union and the City effective January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2018.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
