

RESOLUTION NO. 1-2022

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FERRIS CHEVROLET TO PURCHASE A 2022 CHEVY SILVERADO 3500HD 4WD AND NECESSARY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PARK DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$43,875.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of City of New Philadelphia, desires to purchase a new vehicle for the Park Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Service Director is authorized to enter into an agreement with Ferris Chevrolet through the state cooperative purchasing program to purchase a 2022 Chevy Silverado 3500HD 4WD and necessary equipment, at a cost not to exceed \$43,875.00.

SECTION 2. The cost of the new truck shall be paid from line-item No. 101-437-5-5204 and shall not exceed \$43,875.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
