

RESOLUTION NO. 21-2022

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO PAY \$20,000.00 TO THE NEW PHILADELPHIA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE REFURBISHING OF THE TRACK AT WOODY HAYES QUAKER STADIUM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia owns Woody Hayes Quaker Stadium, and all the citizens of the City are afforded usage of the track there for exercise purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, has agreed to assist the New Philadelphia School District in their plan to completely refurbish the track at Woody Hayes Quaker Stadium by contributing \$50,000.00 towards the project, \$30,000.00 of which has already been approved; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia now desires to allocate the remaining \$20,000.00 towards the complete refurbishing of the track at Woody Hayes Quaker Stadium as part of its \$50,000.00 commitment to the New Philadelphia School District for the same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the City of New Philadelphia, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Auditor is authorized to pay \$20,000.00 to the New Philadelphia City School District for the refurbishing of the track at Woody Hayes Stadium, from the Master Capital Improvement Fund, line-item number 437-7700-5-52-4 for the purposes of refurbishing the track at Woody Hayes Quaker Stadium.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
