

RESOLUTION NO. 43-2017

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO IN SUPPORT OF THE TUSCORA PARK FOUNDATION APPLICATION FOR GRANT ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE CLEAN OHIO CONSERVATION FUND FOR THE SOUTH SIDE COMMUNITY PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund provides grant assistance to the State of Ohio for conservation purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Tuscora Park Foundation of the City of New Philadelphia desires grant assistance from the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund for the Southside Community Park Improvement Project, and

WHEREAS, the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund application process requires support from the City in which the subject property is located, and

WHEREAS, all of the Southside Community Park Improvement Project is located in Tuscarawas County, and

WHEREAS, the Tuscora Park Foundation has provided the City of New Philadelphia with a description of the Southside Community Park Improvement Project

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of New Philadelphia Ohio fully supports the efforts of the Tuscora Park Foundation to apply for grant assistance through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund for the Southside Community Park Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


