

RESOLUTION NO. 7-2025

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A LOAN AGREEMENT WITH FIRST FEDERAL COMMUNITY BANK TO PURCHASE A NEW AMBULANCE AND NECESSARY EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AS PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION 11-2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of City of New Philadelphia, desires to enter into a loan agreement for the purchase of a new ambulance for the Fire Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Safety Director is authorized to enter into a loan agreement with First Federal Community Bank to purchase a new ambulance, as authorized by Resolution 11-2024, the proposed terms of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2. The loan payments are to be paid at Auditor's discretion from either line item 715, Ambulance Fund or line item 420.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


