PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL DAVE JOHNSON EXPLAINED THAT THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS TO DISCUSS THE AIRPORT RESTAURANT LEASE, AND TAKE POSSIBLE ACTION ON ORDINANCE 70-2002 AND 71-2002.

HE SAID HE HAS MADE NUMEROUS ATTEMPTS TO SPEAK TO SOMEONE IN THE LIQUOR PERMIT DIVISION TO DETERMINE THE EXACT AMOUNT OWED, BUT HAS HAD NO SUCCESS.
