

ORDINANCE NO. 21-2024

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, TO INCREASE ALL SANITATION ACCOUNTS BY THREE DOLLARS (\$3.00) PER MONTH. SANITATION ACCOUNT BILLS MAILED IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2024 SHALL REFLECT THE RATE INCREASE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, to offset expenses associated with the Sanitation Department in order to maintain the City's recycle program, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio has determined it is necessary to increase sanitation rates by \$3.00 per month.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Every sanitation account shall be raised by \$3.00 per month effective the full billing cycle for bills mailed in November 2024.

SECTION 2. The \$3.00 increase per account per month will generate approximately \$280,000 per year to offset Sanitation Department expenses in order the maintain the City's recycle program due to current rate increases for the same.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force as of November 1, 2024 or immediately upon passage whichever first occurs.


