ORDINANCE NO. 25-2018

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO AMEND CHAPTER 353.09, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA REGARDING THE WAIVER OF FINES FOR VIOLATION OF PARKING METERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia previously enacted Chapter 353 Parking Meters of the City of New Philadelphia.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia desires to amend Chapter 353.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of New Philadelphia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That previously enacted Chapter 353.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of New Philadelphia is hereby amended to read as follows:

353.09 Waiver

(a) The owner or operator of a vehicle who has been ticketed for an expired meter may within twenty-four hours of the time of such offense, appear at the New Philadelphia Police Department and pay the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) for full satisfaction of such violation. If not paid within twenty-four hours of the time of such offense the fine will be twenty dollars (\$20.00).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
