

RESOLUTION NO. 14-2024

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MONTROSE FORD LLC AND HALL PUBLIC SAFETY TO PURCHASE A 2025 FORD EXPLORER AND NECESSARY EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$71,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of City of New Philadelphia, desires to purchase a new police cruiser vehicle for the Police Department to be utilized for the school resource officer, the costs of which will come from the Opioid settlement funds and be shared by the New Philadelphia City School District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Safety Director is authorized to enter into an agreement with Montrose Ford LLC and Hall Public Safety to purchase a 2025 Ford Explorers and necessary equipment, at a cost not to exceed \$71,000.00

SECTION 2. The cost of the new vehicles shall be paid from line-item No. 228-2300-5-5200 and shall not exceed \$71,000.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


